

A Brief History of the Wednesday Morning Senior Men's Pebblewood Golf League 2006 - 2024

The league in 2006 had 16 teams. Each team had 5 players... four scheduled players and one team substitute. Players would begin arriving at the course around 7:30. By 8:00, there were 30 - 40 guys milling around in the area between the 1st and 10th tees trying to find their foursome members. As soon as a scheduled foursome had arrived, one of the players would drop a ball into the tee time lineup device on the first tee. Players on the back nine would put a ball into a lineup of balls in the grass on the 10th tee, most of the time at the end of the line. The last group teed off when their fourth player arrived. Many players observed that balls were being put into the lineup much earlier than rules allowed.

2024 changed the Red Tees age to 75 after several years of resistance. Handicap basis changed (again) from 5 rounds to 8 rounds to try to improve stability. Pebblewood's \$35 rate increase was offset by eliminating position payouts at our year-end banquet. The league portion of player fees was reduced from \$45 to \$25. Players had to pay to enter the low net contest. Golfers signed up for the skins game before our season opener.
